Crafts:





Praise Shakers:

Supplies:

Container to hold rice, beans or beads, ie...plastic eggs, paper plates, cups or plastic container

Something that will make noise, ie..beans, popcorn, rice or sand Tape or stapler

Stickers

Markers, crayons, or sharpie for drawing on plastic eggs



Directions:

Place beans, popcorn, or rice inside your chosen container. Seal the container with tape, staples, or something that will keep the contents inside! Use stickers, markers, crayons to decorate the outside. Play a song and use your shakers to praise Jesus!



Paper Palms:

Supplies:

Green construction paper- if you don't have any use white paper and then color it with green markers, paint, or crayons! glue stick or tap wooden craft sticks kids' scissors

Directions:

Fold the green paper in half and then cut a "half moon" shape to look like a palm branch shape. Then Cut little slits around the

perimeter of the half moon shape using child-safe scissors to make it look like a leaf. Glue or tape the craft stick to your palm leaf. Have fun waving your palms for Jesus!





What other ways can you praise Jesus this week?

Holy Week/ Maundy Thursday John 13:1-17

From The Beginners Bible:

Jesus and his disciples gathered together for a special Passover meal. Jesus knew he would be leaving them soon. After supper, Jesus removed his outer clothing. He wrapped a towel around his waist. Then he filled the bowl with water. Jesus washed and dried the disciples' feet one by one. Then it was Peter's turn. He said to Jesus, "Lord, you should never

wash my feet." Jesus answered, "I must wash your feet for you to be part of my kingdom." Then he said to them all, "As I have washed your feet, you must watch each other's feet." By doing this, Jesus showed his friends how to love and serve each other.

What is Maundy Thursday?

Maundy Thursday is the day when many Christians remember and celebrate Jesus' final meal (the Last Supper or Lord's Supper). During the final meal with His disciples (it was a Passover meal), Jesus said and did many things to prepare His disciples for His impending death and departure. One of the things He said was, "I give you a new command: Love one another. Just as I have loved you, you must also love one another" (John 13:34). He repeated this "new command" in John 15:12 and 17. So, one of the things that night is remembered for is the "new command" of love Jesus gave to His disciples. There were other things as well, Jesus prepared His disciples for a new time when He would not be with them, He stressed the need for His people to love one another.
